

## **Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)**

**This program is currently closed – check back in fall of 2018.**

The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program or better known as LIHEAP is a grant program that helps low-income families pay their heating and utility bills.

Cash Grants: This grant is sent directly to the utility company or fuel provider. You do not have to be out of fuel or have a disconnection notice for electric to apply for this grant.

- Crisis Grant: This money will be sent directly to the utility company or fuel provider. To be eligible for this grant, you need to have an emergency situation. An emergency is considered: broken heating equipment or leaking lines, lack of fuel, termination of utility service, danger of being without fuel and electric service.

If you have received LIHEAP last year, you should have already received an application. Should this be your first time applying, you can get an application by:
